MONSOON SEASON ADVISORY FOR STUDENTS

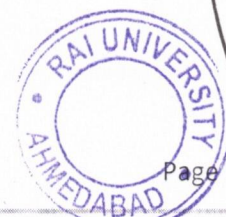
All the students are advised to read and follow the instructions throughout the monsoon season.

1. GENERAL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Remain updated with weather forecasts, rainfall warnings, and official advisories issued by authorities.
- Avoid venturing outdoors during periods of intense rainfall, thunderstorms, or strong winds.
- Inform parents, guardians, hostel wardens, or roommates about travel plans (if necessary) during adverse weather conditions.
- Carry charged mobile phone at all times.
- Always save important emergency contact numbers.
- Keep essential documents, identity cards, mobile phone and other important materials in waterproof bags.

2. TRANSPORTATION SAFETY

- Use university transport facility and avoid personal vehicle to commute to campus.
- Check weather conditions and traffic updates before starting the travel of any type.
- Leave early to account for delays caused by heavy rain, road closures, or traffic congestion.
- Carry an umbrella, raincoat, waterproof footwear, and a spare set of clothes if required.
- Use only safe and familiar routes.
- Avoid shortcuts through flooded roads, underpasses, vacant plots, or construction areas.
- Exercise caution when boarding and exiting bus, car or other public transportation.
- Keep personal belongings secured and protected from water damage.
- Avoid mobile phone usage while walking on wet roads.
- Wear helmet while driving two wheelers.
- Reduce speed significantly during rainfall.





- Maintain safe distances from other vehicles.
- Avoid sudden braking and sharp turns on slippery roads.
- Do not ride through fast-moving or deep water.
- Avoid driving through waterlogged roads.
- Keep emergency supplies and a first-aid kit in the vehicle.

3. ELECTRICAL SAFETY

- Never touch exposed wires or damaged electrical equipment.
- Avoid contact with electrical poles, transformers, junction boxes, and streetlights during or after rain.
- Report sparking, fallen wires, or damaged electrical installations immediately.
- Keep hands dry when operating electrical appliances.
- Avoid charging devices in wet environments.
- Stay away from areas where electrical installations are submerged in water.

NOTE: Students should immediately report the university administration for:

Water seepage near electrical outlets/Electrical sparks/Burning smells/Frequent power fluctuations in campus.

4. HEALTH AND HYGIENE ADVISORY

- Consume freshly prepared food.
- Avoid stale, uncovered, or improperly stored food.
- Avoid cut fruits and unhygienic food.
- Drink boiled, filtered, or purified water only.
- Avoid drinking water from unknown or unsafe sources.
- Change wet clothes promptly.
- Dry shoes and socks completely before reuse.
- Maintain proper personal hygiene.

5. HOSTEL SAFETY

- Keep rooms clean and dry.
- Ensure windows and doors are secured during heavy rain.
- Avoid storing belongings directly on the floor.
- Report leaks, drainage issues, or structural concerns immediately.





- Follow all instructions issued by hostel administration.

6. PREVENTION OF MONSOON-RELATED ILLNESSES

- Students should be aware of symptoms associated with common monsoon diseases and seek medical attention even if they experience minor symptoms

7. FOLLOW OFFICIAL INSTRUCTIONS ALWAYS:

- Do not rely on misinformation and rumours during adverse weather conditions.
- Always follow/relay on the official advisory issued by Indian Meteorological Department (IMD), local authorities or university administration.

8. EMERGENCY RESPONSE GUIDELINES IN UNIVERSITY CAMPUS

- Contact administration if immediate assistance is required.
- Stay calm and follow instructions from university officials.
- Avoid spreading unverified information.
- Assist others only if it is safe to do so.
