AEIC - Rai University Ahmedabad Collaboration Agreement

Party A: Guangzhou Keo Information Technology Co., Ltd. (AEIC Academic Exchange Center)

Party B: Rai University Ahmedabad, India

Upon mutual consent. Party A and Party B, adhering to the principle of promoting academic development and cooperative progress, have agreed on the collaboration for the 3rd International Conference on Computer Science, Electronic Information Engineering and Intelligent Control Technology (CFI 2023) - Indian Session. The agreement is as follows, to be jointly adhered to and executed by both parties:

- Conference Name: The 3rd International Conference on Computer Science, Electronic Information Engineering and Intelligent Control Technology (hereunder referred to as "CEI 2023")
- II. Time and Place: October 13-15, 2023 (tentative), Rai University Ahmedobad, India
- III. Conference Format: Hybrid

IV. Joint Responsibilities

- 1. Party A, being the Organizer of CFI 2023, authorize Party B to be the Co-organizer of CEI 2023 and solely responsible for CEI 2023 Indian Session (thereunder referred to as "Indian Session"). Party A and B will jointly carry out the planning, promotion, and organization of Indian Session. The promotional channels include but are not limited to the conference official website, official We-Media, and cooperative channels, etc.
- 2. Party A and B jointly determine the theme, time, location, and other busic information of Indian Session

V. Rights and Obligations of Party A

1. As the principal organizer of CLL 2023, Party A is responsible for all main conference matters, including but not limited to, inviting experts to serve as



conference chairmen, publishing chairmen, keynote speakers, committee chairmen and members, main venue conference organization and execution, etc.

- 2 Party A is responsible for the construction and maintenance of the official conference website.
- 3 Party A is responsible for conference promotion and publicity on the official website, public media, official We-Media, and other related channels.
- 4. Party A is responsible for assembling a review panel to review papers, and for follow-up on post-conference paper publication and retrieval services.

VI. Rights and Obligations of Party B

- 1 As the co-organizer of CEI 2023 Indian Session, Party B is responsible for arranging the offline venue for Indian Session and execution of the session organization.
- 2 Party B is responsible for inviting a conference emece, two full professors to serve as keynote speakers and some oral presenters for the Indian Session, and organizing at least 20 offline participants (Party A provides ten free places of oral presentation to the Indian Session). The two session keynote speakers will jointly select 1-2 excellent oral reports, for which Party A will award certificates and prizes.
- 3 Party B must promote the conference on Rai University's official website, official media, and other related academic channels.
- 4 Party B has the obligation to invite local scholars to submit papers to the conference, and Party A provides submission fee discounts based on the actual number of papers submitted.
- 5 Party B has the obligation to provide necessary collaboration to Party A in matters related to this conference that do not result in actual costs.

VII. Payment of Academic Honorarium for Indian Session

- 1 Party A shall provide a total budget of USD \$700 to cover honorariums for two keynote speakers and conference organization expenses for Party B.
- 2 Party A shall undertake the actual expenses or costs up to USD \$140, but Party B must provide a breakdown of materials for review and approval by Party A before making any purchases.

- 3. Parix A shall provide Party B with 20 complimentary conference registrations, including 10 for conference attendance only and 10 with allotted slots for oral presenters,
- 4 Should the number of conference attendance only registrants exceed 10, a registration fee of USD \$80 shall be charged starting from the 11th registrant, with 60% of the revenue going to Party B and 40% to Party A.
- 5 Should the number of oral presenters exceed 10, a presentation fee of USD S100 shall be charged starting from the 11th presenter, with the revenue split evenly between the two Parties.
- 6 Should Party B receive paper submissions, Party A may provide a discounted submission price of USD \$150 per paper.
- 7 All charged registration fees, presentation fees, and paper submission fees shall be collected through Party A's website.
- 8 Within two months from the end of the conference, Party A will pay Party B by transferring to Party B's designated bank account.

VIII. Principle of Change

Unless the following conditions occur, Party B has no right to change the service:

- 1 The conference is suspended or changed due to force majeure.
- 2 War or political events.
- 3 The conference is rendered impossible to be held due to changes in policy or law.
- 4 If Party B fails to meet Party A's requirements, Party A has the right to terminate the cooperation.

IX. Supplementary Agreement

Matters not covered by this proposal will be jointly negotiated and a supplementary agreement will be signed separately by the responsible persons of both parties. This supplementary agreement will serve as an appendix to this agreement and has the same legal effect
